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Purpose Of The Role:

To provide the service subscribers with the support needed to comply with their legal obligations under the GDPR Regulations by developing, implementing and managing appropriate data protection practices within the school and providing specialist advice to others.

Key Duties And Responsibilities:

- To provide specialist advice, guidance and training to SMT, governors and employees regarding their legal obligations under the General Data Protection Regulations and promote good practice in data protection management;
- Work with each school's Data Protection Lead to develop, implement and enforce suitable and relevant Data Protection policies and practices and ensure these are reviewed on an annual basis;
- To monitor compliance with the GDPR and other data protection provisions;
- To coordinate internal data collection, processing and retention activities in accordance with GDPR provisions, maintaining comprehensive records of all data processing activities;
- Provide guidance with requests for information in accordance with the GDPR or FOI provisions keeping a log of requests received;
- To be the first point of contact for supervisory authorities on behalf of the school;
- To provide advice and support with the undertaking of data protection impact assessments as required;
- To ensure any data breaches are investigated and remedial actions taken, reporting breaches to the ICO in accordance with legal requirements;
- To keep Data Protection Leads apprised of any changes to data protection / management requirements and ensure school practices are reviewed accordingly.
